





As early summer arrives, long spikes of indigo blue flowers emerge just above the foliage, further enhancing its allure. Golden Anniversary is best for zones 4-9, blooms late summer to early fall requiring minimal maintenance to thrive.




DIPLADENIA SUN PARASOL® FIRED UPTM ORANGE (D)
